DECK

- **Anchor Well:**
 - 66# Bruce style anchor
 - 250' chain
 - Lofrans windlass with power up and power down foot controls
 - Brake handle.
 - Anchor snubber
- **Sail Locker:**
 - Bow thruster mechanics at bottom
 - Cruising spinnaker, sheets and turning block, all in turtle
 - 40 gallon forward holding tank
 - Fender stowage & fender step.
- **Mast:**
 - Deck light shining forward
 - Courtesy flag halyard, starboard spreader, SJS pennant
- **Coachroof grabrails:**
 - Mop
 - Boat hook
- **Cockpit locker, starboard:**
 - Bin 1
 - Power cord adapters and converters
 - Strobe light
 - Bin 2
 - Hose nozzles
 - Box of deep cleaning supplies
 - Bucket with cleaning supplies
 - Bin 3
 - Spare 44# Bruce anchor, chain and rode stowed in plastic boxes.
 - Spare dock lines
 - Fresh water hose
 - Life sling
 - Telescoping deck brush
 - Toilet bowl pump
- **Cockpit locker, port:**



- Bin 1
 - Box for extra lines
 - Including “easy docker” for heavy side winds
 - Companionway cover
- Bin 2
 - Life jackets
- Bin 3
 - Hand bilge pump for dinghy
 - Crab ring, with bait box
 - Misc fishing & crabbing supplies and float
- 600’ spool of floating polypropylene shore line
- Emergency tiller
- Folding step stool
- Seat cushion



- **Cockpit helm, starboard:**
 - Leather covered wheel and custom pedestal guard
 - Bow thruster control, depth, autopilot
 - Icom VHF RAM mike
 - Throttle, tachometer, fuel gauge, key start
- **Cockpit helm lazarette, starboard:**
 - Cabin heat expansion tank and overflow tank
 - Cockpit shower ON/OFF valve
- **Cockpit table:**
 - Chart plotter/radar,
 - Two large fold up leaves
 - Center icebox for sail tie, plastic electronic cover stowage, etc.
 - Windspeed/wind angle and knotmeter displays at aft end
 - 6 cup holders
 - 2 stereo speakers
- **Cockpit helm port:**
 - Leather covered wheel and custom pedestal guard
 - Compass
- **Cockpit helm lazarette, port:**
 - Propane well with 2 tanks
 - Solenoid valve
 - In-line blue gate valve for propane BBQ
 - Spare BBQ regulator

- **Cockpit sole between helms:**
 - Liferaft stowage area used for excess garbage (caution: avoid entangling in steering gear.)
 - Aft hold tank
 - Hot water tank
- **Stern rail, starboard:**
 - GPS antenna
 - Cell phone signal booster antenna
 - 2hp Honda outboard on mount
 - US flag
 - Lifesling
- **Stern rail, port:**
 - Propane large cylindrical BBQ
 - XM satellite radio antenna

INTERIOR



- **Water Stateroom** (Forward starboard):
 - Hanging locker w/ plastic hangers
 - Drawers
 - Large radar reflector and storage under mattress
 - Cabin heat fan and controls
 - 85 gallon water tank under

- **Air Stateroom** (Forward port):

- **PFDs in hanging locker**

- **Fire extinguisher**

- Hanging locker w/ plastic hangers
- Drawers
- Cabinet with shelves
- Long term spares and additional stowage under mattresses
- Cabin heat fan and controls
- 85 gallon water tank under

- **Galley:**

- Tall cabinet with 4 storage areas including 3 aluminum wire slide out drawers, with anti-heeling stops (please fold down to engage stops before sailing). 1 – silverware (service for 10) 2 – juice container, oven pan and cover 3 – bowls, plastic food storage containers, 4 – salad bowls, pot and pans.

- Double sink with cleaning supplies under, water filter for sink cold water, foot pump for salt or fresh water (selector valve under).
- Slide out three layered drawer with knives and various utensils. Please note: the tall, narrow drawer has an indented pull handle, and a typical Jeanneau push knob to secure it. Two things here: 1 - please don't pull on the push knob. It will come off. Use the indented pull handle instead. 2 – remember to secure the drawer with the push knob before sailing—a nice port tack heel will send the drawer crashing.
- Gimballed four burner stove with oven, 12v refrigerator condenser under.
- Top load large refrigerator
- Top load large freezer.
 - This compartment contains both the engine driven cold plate (engage for about ½ hour daily at electrical panel when above 1500 rpm) and the 12V DC thermostat (point white dot aft for normal operation).
 - Note: for safety, please note that the spring lid supports are designed to collapse when touched. Accidental nudging while sorting through the refrigerator can cause a sore head!
 - To close, please nudge the spring to collapse it rather than pulling down on the lid. Thank you.
- Hi-Definition 22” TV with integrated DVD player on swivel mount above freezer.
- Inverter, 12v to 120v, on shelf above of freezer; feeds TV.
- Spice rack with spices, lighters and matches (top of center island settee back).
- Several over counter storage cabinets for dishes (service for 10) and food.
- **Forward Head** (forward end of main salon)
 - Jabsco salt-water toilet with Y valve, vinegar and vegetable oil on shelves.
 - Sink faucet extends for integral shower

**** Important!!! Do not** flush any toilet paper or other items, especially feminine hygiene products at all. Nothing goes down the toilet that hasn't been eaten.

We cannot emphasize this enough.

It will plug the lines and/or damage the pump, resulting in the inability of using the head completely, thus leaving human waste remaining in bowl. We have had guests ignoring this warning, thus spending their vacation with toilet full of human waste, spilling out onto the surrounding area while under way. Please use the bio-degradable or zip lock bags to store paper or other items.

- **Settee** (clockwise from island)
 - Large storage area under island settee, sump and float switch under storage area.
 - Second storage area under forward settee
 - Starboard settee has storage above (cabinets), behind seat backs, and below seat cushions (main salon heater fan, engine start battery). Rolled charts and library.
 - Starboard aft corner, behind seat back holds maintenance items such as sewing kit, spare filters, oil absorbent pads, WD-40 and similar items.
 - Aft settee seat

- 3 tool boxes
 - spare engine oil & coolant
 - Dinghy pump and repair kit
- At port end of aft settee seat, behind cabinet door: water tank selector switches.
- **Nav Station:**
 - **Emergency gear bag** (white nylon mesh) with fog horn, flares, etc. in narrow slot storage under stereo speaker selector cabinet.
 - Under nav table lid: various navigation tools, San Juan Islands chart book, current atlas, etc.
 - Controls for cabin heat, AC and DC as outlined in Owners Notes
 - Stereo speaker selector switch behind cabinet door to starboard of nav station.
- **Bin to starboard of nav table:**
 - Binoculars
 - Canadian courtesy flag
 - Charter Guest Reference Notebook, stereo binder.
 - winch handles
- Nav station seat:
 - batteries
 - cabin heat fan for starboard aft stateroom.
 - lights
- Under nav table
 - bilge pump
 - screens filters for each.
 - water pump
- **Aft Head,** (aft port end of main salon)
 - electric fresh water toilet with Y valve
 - Sink faucet extends for integral shower

- **Fire Stateroom** (aft port):
 - Cabinet with shelves
 - Hanging locker with plastic hangers
 - House battery bank under bed
 - Access to Engine
 - Auto transmission dip-stick access through engine access.

- **Earth Stateroom** (aft starboard):



- Cabinet with shelves
- Diesel tank under bed
- Electronic “brains”, including autopilot fluxgate compass, in hanging locker. Note: Any metal, especially magnets, in this stateroom may adversely affect the autopilot.
- Hanging locker with plastic hangers.
- Oil dipstick access through engine access.
- Stowage under

- **Base of Companionway:**

- Red battery switches (please leave alone)
- Emergency combiner switch in case house bank needed to start engine
- Windlass circuit breaker

** **Note:** bottom two steps remove to access front of engine, raw water strainer and engine-driven freezer compressor.
