· ***** **ANCHORING GEAR / FORWARD LOCKER** *****

- **60 lb Manson Boss Anchor 250'** of 3/8" galvanized chain in main chain locker
- 50 feet of 3/8 galvanized chain with stainless shackle plus 300 feet of 5/8 nylon rode in secondary anchor locker under Hawse pipe cover at bow pulpit (secondary anchor in aft lazarette)
- Lofrans Tigres windlass
- Snubber system with anchor chain plate and dual shackle spliced to 15' of 3/4" nylon ropes
- Anchor chain wash down spigot /hose/nozzle in lazarette
- Deck brush
- Telescoping boat hook
- Manual windlass bar

*****SAFETY GEAR*****

Please take time to familiarize yourself with the location and operation of the safety gear.

Emergency VHF call button with AIS MMSI identification of Odyssey and ability to send her exact GPS location directly to Coast Guard (on lower helm VHF)

All three staterooms have independent **carbon monoxide detectors** permanently installed

- Orange life ring beside stairs to flybridge
- **Life sling** mounted to rail of flybridge stairs
- **Fire extinguishers** portable. (7)
 - one affixed to the wall in the salon next to the starboard entry door.
 - one under setee on starboard side behind helm seat
 - one on flybridge to the left of helm
 - one under bottom step of stairs to aft cabin
 - two in v berth in cupboard under v berth
 - one unattached in port aft engine room near tool box.
- Horn (push button) built in at helm station. (lower helm and flybridge)

Portable air horn in drawer under lower helm seat

- **Flare kit** in drawer under lower helm seat.
- Flashlights located in the helm counter box to left of companionway, in the engine room on forward port bulkhead, and in each stateroom.

Updated 05/15/2014

- **Bilge pumps forward and aft. (The bilge pumps should be in automatic position (at control panel.) emergency hand pump under parquet floor in main salon (engine room near port fuel tank)**
- **Wooden seacock plugs attached with nylon line to each seacock through hull.**
- **First aid kit** at main salon under seat behind port entry door. Extra bandages in kit under bottom step of stairs to aft cabin.
