

# Finding things aboard the Argonaut:

**Helmsman's Seat: Upper shelf – Attached by cable –1 chrome deep-reach deck key for fuel fill, winch handle, foghorn, signal horn, deck plate key**

**Lazarette: (access by tilting helmsman's seat completely forward)  
Emergency tiller, boarding ladder, shore tie large spool of line**

**Companionway stairs: Electrical panel, spare lines, wastebasket, pole for deck brush**

**Deck boxes:**

**Aft (2) – propane tanks (Open aft box bronze deck plate to change valve, if necessary. Forward tank is normally “open”. If propane isn't flowing check forward tank valve first.)**

**Forward –small dingy anchor, chain snubber, bucket, boat soap, hose, windlass handle, crab buoy and line. Stow – power cord, butterfly cover, box cover, short anchor chain washdown hose and blue activator plug pump**

**Port –For storage**

**Starboard – Dock grabber line. Stow – small covers**

**Belaying pins – Hang dock lines**

**Deck: Boat hook and kayak**

**Deck area ahead of butterfly hatch: Stow fenders**

**Aft/ strbrd berth: 2 pillows, comforters (2), fire extinguisher, kayak paddle**

**Hanging locker: fire extinguisher, 6 life jackets**

**Aft/port berth: 2 pillows, comforter, fire extinguisher, access to lazarette, manual bilge pump handle, plexiglass insert for companionway**

**Nav station:**

**Chart table** – San Juan Island Waterproof charts, parallel rule/dividers, hand held compass, batteries, bell, chartplotter and quick start manual, Canadian courtesy flag and BYC penant, engine keys (2 sets on blue floats), spare waste deck plate keys, flashlights, Ethernet cable for internet connection, tapered wooden plugs (3), air horns, cotter pins and rings, GPS and manual, tell tales, pump for fenders, discharge notice, . . .  
**Under nav station seat** – tools, screws, bolts, parts, lubricants.  
**Other repair items are under aft port and strbrd berths.**

**Galley area:**

**Aft cupboard** (across from sink) – kitchen cleaning supplies, trash bags

**Counter** – knife storage.

**Hanging cupboard** – available for storage, insulated French press

**Drawers** – top: silverware for 8 and serving utensils - middle: kitchen implements of all kinds, igniter - bottom:– wine glasses

**Port cupboards** – Dishes for 8 (lg and sm plates, bowls, glasses),

**Microwave** – cutting board underneath

**Stove** – teakettle, and dish rack (underneath)

**Settee/dinette area:**

**STARBOARD:**

**Lower cupboard** (ahead of nav station) – pots and pans (don't miss the large crab pot), pitcher, strainer, colander, covered casserole, barbeque tools, hanging cup holders . . .

**Forward cupboard** – first aid kit, flare kit, air horns, diving equipment

**Shelves** – ensign, charts (#18421, 3441, 3442, 3443) books (Waggoner's, Chapman's, Gunkholing in the San Juans, Gunkholing in the Gulf Islands, Cruising Guide to Puget Sound, Port and Passes/current tables), binoculars

**Under settee:** Bosun's chair, vacuum, dust pan and brush, dingy pump

**Behind settee:** spare bulbs for all lights, spare globe for hanging light, cup holders, and hanging cup holders for cockpit, coffee carafe

**PORT:**

**Pilot berth: 3 Argonaut blankets.**

**Dinette seat storage: Beverage storage cutouts in every corner,  
life jackets under frwd dinette cushion.**

**Hanging lockers: Spare parts and rebuilding kits under “floor” boards.  
Lockers available for personal items.**

**V-berth: 2 pillows, comforter**
