6. INSIDE SLIDING SETTEE SEAT

- a. Nesting food storage containers
- b. Frying pans

7. INSIDE HATCH UNDER FORWARD CUSHION OF DINETTE

- a. Cooking pots
- b. Casserole dishes

8. CABINET OVER DINETTE

- a. 6 Large tumblers
- b. 6 Small cocktail glasses
- c. 6 wine glasses

9. STBD COCKPIT LOCKER

- a. 110 volt AC breaker switch (occasionally breaks)
- b. Emergency tiller
- c. Dinghy pump
- d. Light (attachable) for dinghy
- e. Spare engine oil
- f. Storage for shore power cord
- g. Boat hook

10. PORT COCKPIT LOCKER

- a. Propane compartment (under a hatch), good place (on top of hatch) to stow binnacle cover and instrument covers while underway.
- b. 180 feet of 3/4-inch rode (for extra scope on primary anchor in storm conditions)
- c. Secondary anchor, chain and rode
- d. Manual Bilge Pump Handle
- e. 2 bow lines
- f. 1 stern line
- g. 2 spring lines

- h. E-Z Docker (tossable line)
- i. Toolbox (black canvas)
 - i. Yanmar Spare Parts Box (includes Belts, Filters, Gaskets and Impeller)
 - ii. Tools (various, metric and standard)
 - iii. WD 40
 - iv. Duck Tape
 - v. Misc nuts/bolts/cotter pins/ties/hose clamps/spare bulbs
- j. Cockpit cushions
- k. Crab ring & line
- l. Bucket & boat cleaning supplies
- m. Fitted cockpit cushions, total of 6 for all seats including companionway
