1. NAV STATION TABLE (under table, in port-side open compartment, or on shelf above)
 - a. Ignition & Cabin Keys on Float
 - b. Remote Mic for VHF (if not plugged in at cockpit plug)
 - c. Mapttech Waterproof Chart Book: San Juan Islands
 - d. Gulf Islands Chart Book (not waterproof) in protective see-thru pouch
 - e. Roll charts (please roll with ink facing out): San Juans -18421, Gulf Islands - 3441, 3442, 3443
 - f. Current Atlas & Current Atlas Tables
 - g. Ports & Passes
 - h. Cruise Guides to San Juans & Canadian Gulf Islands
 - i. Hand bearing compass
 - j. Dividers
 - k. Parallel rules
 - l. Mechanical pencils
 - m. Spare batteries
 - n. Canadian courtesy pennant
 - o. Maglite flashlight (mounted)

 - e. Air horn (spare air canister)
 - f. Flair signal kit
 - g. General & engine spares
 - h. Spare BBQ regulator
 - i. Tools (in plastic box & in brown canvas bag marked "Tools")

3. CUPBOARD NEAR TV

- a. DVD Collection
- b. Cruising Guides
- c. Books

4. UNDER FORWARD-MOST DINETTE CUSHION

- a. Alternator (spare)
- b. Starter (spare)
- c. Raw Water Pump (spare)
- d. Toilet pump (spare)
- e. Domestic water pump (spare)
- f. Shower sump pump (spare)

5. UNDER AFT-MOST DINETTE CUSHION

- a. Pots & Pans
- b. Backing Dishes
- c. Colander
- d. Crab cooking pot

6. UNDER AFT-MOST SETEE CUSHION

- a. Fill wood panel for under nave table to extend settee to make single berth
- b. Cushion that goes on top

7. PORT COCKPIT LOCKER

- a. Stowage for Companionway (Plexiglas) Board – please inside blue sail bag to keep from scratching
- b. Fueling gloves (green) & absorbent pads
- c. Emergency tiller
- d. Dinghy pump
- e. Dinghy repair kit
- f. Spare engine oil
- g. Spare engine coolant
- h. Storage for shore power cord
- i. Radar reflector
- j. Funnel
- k. WD 40
- l. Lubricating 3-in-1 oil
- m. McLube Sail Cote (does not attract grit – for mainsail slides)
- n. Air horn (spare air canister)
- o. Spare prop

8. STARBOARD COCKPIT LOCKER

- a. Life jackets
- b. Secondary anchor shackled to 30' of chain and 150 feet of ½-inch rode
- c. Boat Hook (if not on top of coach roof)
- d. Mooring lines (stowage)
- e. Extra misc. lines
- f. Fenders (stowage)
- g. E-Z Docker (toss-able line with padded hook)
- h. Hose (drinking water safe)
- i. Squeeze nozzle (for hose)
- j. Bucket, boats soap, sponge
- k. Long-handled soft-bristle deck brush

9. PORT AFT LAZARETTE

- a. Propane Bottles (2) – should you need to switch tanks, crescent wrench in bag marked “Tools” under nav table seat

10. STARBOARD AFT LAZARETTE

- a. Charger / Inverter Unit – please keep dry!
- b. Crab ring, line & float
- c. Manual Bilge Pump Handle (mounted in brackets)
- d. 110 volt AC breaker switch (rarely breaks and needs to be reset)
- e. Spool of 600-foot stern tie line – please do not cut
