*****FORWARD CABIN/HEAD*****

- Comforters (2)
- Blankets (2)
- Sleeping pillows (2)
- Mattress pads w/mattress covers (2)
- Throw rug (1)
- Waste basket/toilet brush/liquid hand soap
- First aid kit in bath cabinet
- Electric heater (1) - starboard locker
- Flares/ air horns/ binoculars/ fuel absorbs/ gloves - lower step
- Binoculars/ 30amp / 20 amp adaptor - upper step
- Engine/equipment manuals in starboard hanging locker
- Manual inflating PFD's (2) in starboard hanging locker – store in dinghy
- Fly bridge auto pilot, VHF FB microphone, davit control – starboard locker
- Piloting & Seamanship – Chapman
- Mechanical & Electrical Manual – Calder
- Extra davit & boom controls (3) – lower shelf starboard locker

*****ENGINE ROOM *****

- Spare engine oil/transmission oil/coolant
- Spare filters above starboard fuel tank
- Fire extinguisher

******FLYBRIDGE******

- Propane tanks (2) port side locker
- PFD's full float (4) in white rubber bag starboard side locker
- Settee cover, captain chair covers, instrument cover, dinghy cover, Salon window cover - starboard side locker
- Freezer w/ cover
- Side curtains in protective cover – starboard side
- Settee cushions (6)
- VHF microphone & 3 instrument covers

*****UPPER DECK*****

- Green deck chairs (4) with covers (2)
- Ice chest - white
- Stainless BBQ with cover
- Boat hook starboard side

******STERN LAZARETTE******

- Wash bucket
- Stern line 600'
- Additional dock lines and tie lines
- Hose – 50' – deck wash down hose

******STERN DECK BOX******

- Deck brush with handle
- Soap/Plexiglas cleaner with rag/wax/sponge – in plastic bin
- E-Z Docker – throw able line
- Mop
- Folding fishing ring, floats, and line
- Hose coiled – 50' – fresh water fill hose – in plastic bin
- Hose nozzle

******DECK/BOW LOCKERS******

- Green fenders w/black cloth covers and black leather rail hooks (6)
- Dock lines – 15' and 30' – (7)
- Life sling – man overboard – mounted on stern rail
- Life ring – mounted on upper deck rail at stern
- Spare anchor and road – port locker forward
- Fresh and salt water wash down – port locker forward

- Anchor & anchor chain – 300’ – starboard locker forward

*****DINGHY*****

- 10.5 AB Center console
- 20 HP Honda Engine w/ gas tank
- Inflatable PFD’s in plastic bin (2) in dinghy or fwd cabin locker
- Paddles under seat (2)
- Anchor and line in front storage
- Drain plugs (2) in aft well, **DO NOT LAUNCH WITHOUT PLUG!!**
- Lifting bridle attached to davits – leave in dinghy when launched
- ❖ **NEVER lift dinghy with people or supplies in it, this could cause serious damage to davits!! Remove all unnecessary weight before lifting**
- ❖ **Always make sure dinghy is empty of water before lifting**
- ❖ **Always remove drain plug when storing dinghy**
- ❖ **When tying dinghy to Serenity, tie sideways to swim platform fore and aft; tying nose in to stern will damage swim platform!!**
- ❖ **If anchorage is rough, raise dinghy onto davits**
